JOSHUA

"After Moses the LORD's servant died, the LORD spoke to Joshua, Nun's son. He had been Moses' helper. "My servant Moses is dead. Now get ready to cross over the Jordan with this entire people to the land that I am going to give to the Israelites. I am giving you every place where you set foot, exactly as I promised Moses.

Your territory will stretch from the desert and the Lebanon as far as the great Euphrates River, including all Hittite land, up to the Mediterranean Sea on the west. No one will be able to stand up against you during your lifetime. I will be with you in the same way I was with Moses. I won't desert you or leave you. Be brave and strong, because you are the one who will help this people take possession of the land, which I pledged to give to their ancestors.

"Be very brave and strong as you carefully obey all of the Instruction that Moses my servant commanded you. Don't deviate even a bit from it, either to the right or left. CHECK-IN: Do you see it? Do you hear it?

Fill the earth and subdue it? You have been made to have dominion

over everything? What does this mean to you? Certainly it speaks of

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authority and rulership, but what does physical dominion over all these things produce? What is Yahweh's purpose of giving you authority over all the earth?

Before the disciples ever went out to preach the Good News of Kingdom, Yahshua gave them power and authority and sent them to proclaim the Kingdom! (Luke 9:1-2); (Luke 10:9, 17-19) Two things are coinciding here; <u>authority is given and it is given to establish</u> <u>His Kingdom, a Kingdom which starts within you.</u> (Luke 17:20-21)

EVERY PLACE YOUR FEET TOUCH—CHURCH STYLE!

"Jesus called the Twelve together and he gave them power and authority over all demons and to heal sicknesses. He sent them out to proclaim God's kingdom and to heal the sick. He told them, "Take nothing for the journey—no walking stick, no bag, no bread, no money, not even an extra shirt. Whatever house you enter, remain there until you leave that place. Wherever they don't welcome you, as you leave that city, shake the dust off your feet as a witness against them." 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A PROPHET LIKE MOSES? — THE ONE PIECE FROM THIS WEEK'S READING THAT CAUGHT MY ATTENTION!

"No prophet like Moses has yet emerged in Israel; Moses knew the LORD face-to-face! That's not even to mention all those signs and wonders that the LORD sent Moses to do in Egypt—to Pharaoh, to all his servants, and to his entire land— as well as all the extraordinary power that Moses displayed before Israel's own eyes!" Deuteronomy 34:10-12 CEB

THIS REMINDED ME OF THIS PROPHETIC DECLARATION

"The LORD your God will raise up a prophet like me from your community, from your fellow Israelites. He's the one you must listen to. That's exactly what you requested from the LORD your God at Horeb, on the day of the assembly, when you said, "I can't listen to the LORD my God's voice anymore or look at this great fire any longer. I don't want to die!" The LORD said to me: What they've said is right. I'll raise up a prophet for them from among their fellow Israelites—one just like you. I'll put my words in his mouth, and he will tell them everything I command him. I myself will hold accountable anyone who

doesn't listen to my words, which that prophet will speak in my name." (Deuteronomy 18:15-19)CEB

*WHO IS THIS PROPHET LIKE MOSES who will tell us everything Yahweh command us. And because of whom will Yahweh hold accountable anyone who doesn't listen to his words, which that prophet will speak in Yahweh's name?

A JOURNEY FROM THE FALL TO THE RESTORATION — KEEP IN MIND THE QUESTION—WHO IS THIS PROPHET LIKE MOSES? IT WAS AN IMPORTANT QUESTION IN THE DAYS OF Y'SHUA!

Creation is waiting for deliverance and restoration (Romans 8:18-22)

"For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. For the earnest expectation of the creation **eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God**. For the creation was

subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now."

Romans 8:18-22 NKJV

WHO INITIATES THIS RESTORATION

Elijah is coming first to restore all things (Matthew 17:10-12)

"And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Why then do the scribes say that Elijah must come first?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Indeed, ELIJAH IS COMING FIRST and will RESTORE ALL THINGS. But I say to you that ELIJAH HAS COME ALREADY, and they did not know him [John the Baptist] but did to him whatever they wished. Likewise the Son of Man is also about to suffer at their hands."" (Matthew 17:10-12)

THE RESTORATION PROPHET IS NOT Y'SHUA?

Y'shua is in Heaven UNTIL the restoration (Acts 3:19-21)

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began."

Acts 3:19-21 NKJV

- SO—CREATION IS WAITING FOR THE RESTORATION
- 2. Y'SHUA SAYS ELIJAH IS THE RESTORER
- 3. AND NOW PETER QUOTES THE DEUTERONOMY VERSE THAT SPARKED THE QUESTION—WHO IS THE PROPHET LIKE MOSES?

ACTS CONT.

"For Moses truly said to the fathers, 'The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. **Him you**

shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you. And it shall be that every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.'" (Acts 3:22-23)

Peter is referring to (Deuteronomy 18:15-19)

Why is it important you know who this prophet is?

ANSWER: "every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people."

THEME: "Blessed are the eyes which see the things you see; for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen it, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard it." Luke 10:23-24 NKJV

CHECK-IN: Do you see it? Do you hear it?

A Prophet like Moses initiates the restoration, and it is clear it is not Y'shua who remains in heaven UNTIL the times of refreshing and restoration, and it is clear Y'shua named Elijah as the restoration prophet.

*Who is the Prophet like Moses who is coming, and why must he come before the Messiah? The reason I am taking the time to bring further clarity on the topic is because it is pervasive doctrine throughout all of Christendom that Moses is prophesying about Jesus here. And if you stick with that belief, your prophetic framework for the return of Messiah crumbles, and with it all your roles and responsibilities at the end-of-theage get muddied.

In the interrogation of John the Baptist we learn:

John the Baptist says he's not Elijah but is the voice in the wilderness (John 1:21-23 from Isaiah 40:3)

"And they asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" He said, "I am not." "ARE YOU THE PROPHET?" And he answered, "No." Then they said to him, "Who are you, that we may give an answer to those who sent us? What do you say about yourself?" He said: "I am 'The voice of one crying in the wilderness:

"Make straight the way of the LORD," ' as the prophet Isaiah said [in Is. 40:3]."" (John 1:21-23)

Is John the the prophet [like Moses]? He is not willing to say, but he is sure of one thing; he had to come first to prepare the way for the Messiah. However, Y'shua clears up the uncertainty in a passage we've already explored. Elijah is coming and has come [as John the Baptist].

AGAIN

"And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Why then do the scribes say that Elijah must come first?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Indeed, ELIJAH IS COMING FIRST and will RESTORE ALL THINGS. But I say to you that ELIJAH HAS COME ALREADY, and they did not know him but did to him whatever they wished. Likewise the Son of Man is also about to suffer at their hands."" (Matthew 17:10-12)

"Then the disciples realized he was telling them about John the Baptist." Matthew 17:13

[Messiah preceded by THE PROPHET the first time, and needs to be preceded by THE PROPHET the second time! ELIJAH IS COMING FIRST and will RESTORE ALL THINGS. Were all things restored in the first century—certainly not. If they were, why is creation STILL WAITING?

For the earnest expectation of the creation **eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God**. For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; **because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God**. For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now." Romans 8:19-22

Elijah is THE PROPHET like Moses prophesied in Deuteronomy 18:15-16 and Acts 3:22-23 (whom **No prophet like Moses** has yet to emerge in Israel, Deut. 34)

Who comes Before the Lord and what does he do?

And here is absolute confirmation in the last book of the Old Testament that it is, in fact, Elijah who is the prophet like Moses. Look at even the event referenced in Horeb and the consequences of not obeying... as well as the specific ministry of Elijah (TURN!) AND AFTERWARDS—SEE THAT THIS IS THE EXACT MINISTRY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST (NOT Y'SHUA) AND YET THIS REFERS THE THE ELIJAH WHO COMES BEFORE THE GREAT AND DREADFUL DAY OF THE LORD—NOT JTB!

""Remember the Law of Moses, My servant, Which I commanded him in **Horeb** for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. Behold, I will send you **ELIJAH THE PROPHET** before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD. And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, And the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse."" (Malachi 4:4-6)

"The LORD your God will raise up a prophet like me from your community, from your fellow Israelites. He's the one you must

listen to. That's exactly what you requested from the LORD your God at Horeb, on the day of the assembly, when you said, "I can't listen to the LORD my God's voice anymore or look at this great fire any longer. ALT VERSION

Peter is referring to (Deuteronomy 18:15-16)

THE LIFE OF JOHN WAS PROPHESIED TO BE IN THE SPIRIT OF ELIJAH!

"But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth. For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb. And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God. He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."" Luke 1:13-17 NKIV

THEME: "Blessed are the eyes which see the things you see; for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen it, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard it." Luke 10:23-24 NKJV

CHECK-IN: Do you see it? Do you hear it?

Can you see and hear how important it is to know who the PROPHET LIKE MOSES is who is coming to RESTORE ALL THINGS BEFORE Y'shua returns!

Moses and Elijah are together in the MOUNT OF TRANSFIGURATION:

ONE LAST connection between Moses and Elijah is on the Mount of Transfiguration (read Matthew 17:1-5). Moses and Elijah appear together. And when Peter is speaking, Yahweh's voice proclaimed from the clouds, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." These exact words were echoed from heaven immediately after John (Elijah) baptized Yahshua (read Matthew 3:16-17).

AND—THIS EVENT is the feast of Tabernacles which leads to our SECOND TORAH PORTON.

ACCOUNT OF THE MOUNT OF TRANSFIGURATION—AND THE CONNECTION OF THIS TORAH PORTION WITH THE PORTION FOR THE FEAST—LIGHT—AND WHO WE NEED TO BE IN THE PROCESS!

"Six days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and brought them to the top of a very high mountain. He was transformed in front of them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. Moses and Elijah appeared to

them, talking with Jesus. Peter reacted to all of this by saying to Jesus, "Lord, it's good that we're here. If you want, I'll make three shrines: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." While he was still speaking, look, a bright cloud overshadowed them. A voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son whom I dearly love. I am very **pleased with him.** Listen to him!" Hearing this, the disciples fell on their faces, filled with awe. But Jesus came and touched them. "Get up," he said. "Don't be afraid." When they looked up, they saw no one except Jesus. As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus commanded them, "Don't tell anybody about the vision until the Human One is raised from the dead." The disciples asked, "Then why do the legal experts say that Elijah must first come?" Jesus responded, "Elijah does come first and will restore all things. In fact, I tell you that Elijah has already come, and they didn't know **him.** But they did to him whatever they wanted. In the same way the Human One is also going to suffer at their hands." Then the disciples realized he was telling them about John the Baptist." [SEE THE CONNECTION—LIGHT, TRANSFIGURATION, MOSES, **ELIJAH?]** Matthew 17:1-13 CEB

READING FOR THE SHABBAT IN THE MIDST OF THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES — EXODUS 33 and 34

"And the Word became flesh and dwelt [TABERNACLED] among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." John 1:14 NKJV

*According to the prophet Zechariah, The Shabbat during Sukkoth Ecclesiastes is read aloud during services.

ZECHARIAH—KEEP THE FEAST OR—I STRIKE THE NATIONS—

"And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and **to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.** And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth **do not** come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain. If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; **they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations** who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles."

Zechariah 14:16-18 NKJV

LOOK AT THE TABERNACLES CONNECTION AND THE MINISTRY OF THE PROPHET LIKE MOSES.

Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you. And it shall be that every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.' (Deuteronomy 18)

And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, And the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse."" (Malachi 4)

OUR TWO PORTIONS TODAY—RECEIVING THE TABLETS (EXODUS 33-34) REVIEWING THE TABLETS (DEUTERONOMY 33-34)

HIDE YOUR FACE OR LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE!

"Moses said to the LORD, "Look, you've been telling me, 'Lead these people forward.' But you haven't told me whom you will send with me. Yet you've assured me, 'I know you by name and think highly of you.' Now if you do think highly of me, show me your ways so that I may know you and so that you may really approve

of me. Remember too that this nation is your people." The LORD replied, "I'll go myself, and I'll help you." Moses replied, "If you won't go yourself, don't make us leave here. Because how will anyone know that we have your special approval, [Y'shua, my teaching is not me own (John 7:16)... and If you would have believed Moses (John 5:46)...] both I and your people, unless you go with us? Only that distinguishes us, me and your people, from every other people on the earth." The LORD said to Moses, "I'll do exactly what you've asked because you have my special approval, and I know you by name." ["And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it." (John 14:13-14)...] Moses said, "Please show me your glorious presence." The LORD said, "I'll make all my goodness pass in front of you, and I'll proclaim before you the name, 'The LORD.' I will be kind to whomever I wish to be kind, and I will have compassion to whomever I wish to be compassionate. But," the LORD said, "you can't see my face because no one can see me and live." The LORD said, "Here is a place near me where you will stand beside the rock. As my glorious presence passes by, I'll set you in a gap in the rock, and I'll cover you with my hand until I've passed by. Then I'll take away my hand, and you will see my back, but my face won't be visible."" Exodus 33:12-23 CEB

(34:6-7) "The LORD passed in front of him and proclaimed: "The LORD! The LORD! a God who is compassionate and merciful, very patient, full of great loyalty and faithfulness, showing great loyalty to a thousand generations, forgiving every kind of sin and rebellion, yet by no means clearing the guilty, punishing for their parents' sins their children and their grandchildren, as well as the third and the fourth generation." [And yet in our setting in Deuteronomy ONLY ONE generation has passed before entering the promised land!]

LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE [SOMEWHAT]

(34:29-35) Moses came down from Mount Sinai. As he came down from the mountain with the two covenant tablets in his hand, Moses didn't realize that the skin of his face shone brightly because he had been talking with God. When Aaron and all the Israelites saw the skin of Moses' face shining brightly, they were afraid to come near him. But Moses called them closer. So Aaron and all the leaders of the community came back to him, and Moses spoke with them. After that, all the Israelites came near as well, and Moses commanded them everything that the LORD had spoken with him on Mount Sinai. When Moses finished speaking with

them, he put a veil over his face. Whenever Moses went into the LORD's presence to speak with him, Moses would take the veil off until he came out again. When Moses came out and told the Israelites what he had been commanded, the Israelites would see that the skin of Moses' face was shining brightly. So Moses would put the veil on his face again until the next time he went in to speak with the LORD." Exodus 34:6-7, 22, 24, 29-35 CEB

LUKES VERSION OF THE TRANSFIGURATION

Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings, that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray. **As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered,** and His robe became white and glistening. [LIGHT!] And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem." Luke 9:28-31 NKJV

OUR VERSION OF LIGHT—PAUL AND HIS TAKE ON MOSES' FACE

"The ministry that brought death was carved in letters on stone tablets. It came with such glory that the Israelites couldn't look for

long at Moses' face because his face was shining with glory, even though it was a fading glory. Won't the ministry of the Spirit be **much more glorious?** If the ministry that brought condemnation has glory, how much more glorious is the ministry that brings righteousness? In fact, what was glorious isn't glorious now [in **comparison**], because of the glory that is brighter. If the glory that fades away was glorious, how much more glorious is the one that **lasts!** So, since we have such a hope, we act with great confidence. We aren't like Moses, who used to put a veil over his face so that the Israelites couldn't watch the end of what was fading away. [No, instead we let our light shine!] But their minds were closed. Right up to the present day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. The veil is not removed because it is taken away by Christ. Even today, whenever Moses is read, a veil lies over their hearts. But whenever someone turns back [RESTORATION MINISTRY OF **ELIJAH!**] to the Lord, the veil is removed. [Sermon on the Mount...You've heard it said; I have not come to destroy the Torah or the Prophets but to fulfill] The Lord is the Spirit, and where the Lord's Spirit is, there is freedom. All of us are looking with unveiled faces at the glory of the Lord as if we were looking in a mirror. We are being transformed into that same image from one degree of glory to the next degree of glory. This comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." 2 Corinthians 3:7-18 CEB

We are being transformed into that <u>same image....</u>from one degree of glory to the next degree of glory!

SAME IMAGE!

The Upward call—

"The goal I pursue is the prize of God's upward call in Christ Jesus." Philippians 3:14 CEB

Fullness and Stature and Image —

"until we all reach the unity of faith and knowledge of God's Son. God's goal is for us to become mature adults—to be fully grown, measured by the standard of the fullness [image] of Christ." Ephesians 4:13 CEB

Divine Nature—

"Through his honor and glory he has given us his precious and wonderful promises, that you may share the divine nature and escape from the world's immorality that sinful craving produces."

2 Peter 1:4 CEB

Joint Heirs—

"But if we are children, we are also heirs. We are God's heirs and fellow heirs with Christ, if we really suffer with him so that we can also be glorified with him." Romans 8:17 CEB

Mind of Christ—

ALL AUTHORITY IN HEAVEN AND EARTH—FOR WHAT?

REMEMBER—I am giving you every place where you set foot, exactly as I promised Moses. (Joshua 1:3)

THE COMMISSION!
