Let's Set the Scene: Portion in a blurb

1. The first three chapters of this portion of Scripture deliver a legal code of laws and commandments that form the core for the Torah's laws. The last chapter tells the story of how the people of Israel consented to keep these laws and make their permanent "I do" as they enter into a marriage covenant relationship with God through a series of rituals conducted by Moses.

Exodus 21

- 2. **The Law Concerning Hebrew Servants [Slaves]:** Right from the start, this portion reveals one of the most prophetically significant and relevant scriptures for all those who would come to know Y'shua as the Messiah.
 - (a) A Hebrew servant is in bondage for six years and is then permitted to go out for free without cost in the seventh year.But there are some important stipulations:
 - 1) If he comes in by himself, he shall go out by himself;
 - 2) If he comes in married, then his wife shall go out with him;
 - 3) If his master has given him a wife, and she has borne him sons or daughters, the wife and her children shall be her master's, and he shall go out by himself;
 - 4) But if the servant loves his master, wife, and children, he can choose to stay a servant [and keep his wife and children];
 - 5) If the slave makes a decision to stay, **it is a permanent** and it is witnessed by the judges and consummated with a piercing.
 - 6) What and who does this sound like? A hebrew servant has the option to go free, but he chooses instead to stay, so he can keep the bride he was given while in slavery!

- 7) Because he has chosen to stay, his master shall bring him to the judges. Then he shall bring him for a piercing and he shall serve his master forever.
- 3. Then we see the laws of a female servant and how they differ from males.
- 4. **The Law Concerning Violence:** (violence against another person)
- 5. **Animal Control Laws:** Man vs. Animal, Animal vs. Man, and Animal vs. Animal

Exodus 22

- 6. **Responsibility for Property:** Theft, Fire, Neighbor's Crops, Money and goods, Trespassing, Lost things, and Borrowed things
- 7. **Moral and Ceremonial Principles:** Enticing virgins, Sorcery, Relations with animals, Sacrifices to any god but Yahweh, Treatment of strangers, Widows and Orphans, Laws of lending, Interest and Pledges, Cursing Yahweh and Rulers, First Fruits and Firstborns, and Meat from animals killed in the wild.

Exodus 23

8. **Justice for All:** No false reports, Do not follow a crowd to do evil; Do not testify in a dispute so as to turn aside after many to pervert justice; No partiality to a poor man in his dispute; Help for your enemy's animal; Do not pervert the judgment of the

- poor in his dispute; Keep yourself far from a false matter; Do not kill the innocent and righteous; Take no bribe; and Do not oppress a stranger because you were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- 9. **The Law of Sabbaths:** Sabbath rest for the land; Do not gather your crops in the seventh year but let the poor and beasts eat from your land freely that year; Six days of work and on the seventh day you shall rest, even beasts and servants.
- 10. Be circumspect and make no mention of the name of other gods, nor let it be heard from your mouth.
- 11. **Three Annual Feasts:** "Three times [seasons[you shall keep a feast to Me in the year; Three times in the year all your males shall appear before Yahweh [ultimately in Jerusalem]: (1) Passover (with Unleavened Bread and First Fruits), (2) Feast of Weeks (Shavuot or Pentecost—we see this in Acts 2, SEE POINT #12), and (3) Feast of Tabernacles.
- 12. "When the Day of **Pentecost** had fully come, they were all with **one accord in one place**." (Acts 2:1)
 - a) They were keeping the command to appear before Yahweh for the feast of Shavuot, and not just Jews but everyone who identified as followers of Yahweh, just like the audience he is speaking to in Exodus, a mixed multitude who came out with Israel. (Exodus 12:38)

- b) "And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation [a mixed multitude] under heaven." Acts 2:5
- 13. **The Angel and the Promises:** Yahweh will send an angel before them to keep them in the way and to bring them into the place which He has prepared.
 - a) Beware of Yahweh and obey His voice; then He will be an enemy to their enemies and an adversary to their adversaries.
 - b) He will bless their bread and water.
 - He will take sickness away, miscarriages and barrenness in the land;
 - d) He will fulfill the number of their days.
 - e) He will slowly defeat their enemies before their very eyes.
 - f) He will set their ancient boundaries from the Red Sea to the sea, Philistia, and from the desert to the River.
- 14. Yahweh instructs the people to make no covenant with His enemies, nor with their gods.

Exodus 24

15. Israel Affirms the Covenant (a marriage covenant): Moses came and told the people all the words of the Lord and all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words which the Lord has said we will do." And Moses wrote all the words of the Lord. Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read in

the hearing of the people. And they said, "All that the Lord has said we will do, and be obedient." And Moses took the blood, sprinkled it on the people, and said, "This is the blood of the covenant which the Lord has made with you according to all these words."

- a) Key prophetic point; the marriage covenant is a blood covenant. It takes Faith plus Blood. That is why Y'shua shed His blood so we could be His bride forever.
- 16. Israel on the Mountain with God: Moses went up, also Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and they saw the God of Israel. And He did not lay His hand on them. Then Yahweh said to Moses, "Come up to Me on the mountain and be there; and I will give you tablets of stone, and the law and commandments which I have written, that you may teach them." So Moses arose with his assistant Joshua, and Moses went up to the mountain of God. The cloud covered it six days. And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. The sight of the glory of Yahweh was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel. So Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.

- 17. The Church on the Mountain with God:: "For you have not **come** to the mountain that may be touched and that burned with fire, and to blackness and darkness and tempest, and the sound of a trumpet and the voice of words, so that those who heard it begged that the word should not be spoken to them anymore. (For they could not endure what was commanded: "And if so much as a beast touches the mountain, it shall be stoned or shot with an arrow." And so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I am exceedingly afraid and trembling.") **But** you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel." Hebrews 12:18-24 NKJV

 - A. Heed the voice of the Angel
 - (1) My Name is in Him!

- (a) "Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; for My name is in Him." Exodus 23:20-21 NKJV
- (2) Obey and I will handle your enemies
 - (a) "But **if you indeed obey** His voice and **do all that I speak**, then **I will be an enemy to your enemies** and an adversary to your adversaries." Exodus 23:22 NKJV
- (3) DO NOT worship foreign gods!

- (4) Serve Yahweh!
 - (a) "So you shall **serve the Lord your God**, and **He will bless** your bread and your water. And I will take
 sickness away from the midst of you." Exodus 23:25
 NKJV

- (5) You will be fruitful and live long
 - (a) "No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days." Exodus 23:26 NKJV
- (6) Summary: Angel guide or angel guide
 - (a) Yahweh sends an Angel who bears His Name. It's like a son bears the name of his father. This is one of the pre-incarnate Messiah moments. Y'shua (Yahshua) bears the name of the Father Yahweh. And not only a name, but the Authority! You should fear and obey Him. He has the authority to:
 - 1. Direct your path
 - 2. Fulfill promises
 - 3. Pardon your sins
 - 4. Note: "A man's heart plans his way, **But the Lord** directs his steps." Proverbs 16:9 NKJV
 - (b) If you obey Him He will conquer your enemies
 - (c) DO NOT worship the gods of your enemies, nor serve them in any way that they do. Quite the contrary, destroy all remnants of how they worship their gods.
 - 1. Note: "You shall utterly destroy all the places where the nations which you shall dispossess served their gods, on the high mountains and on the hills and

under every green tree. And you shall destroy their altars, break their sacred pillars, and burn their wooden images with fire; you shall cut down the carved images of their gods and destroy their names from that place. You shall not worship the Lord your God with such things." Deuteronomy 12:2-4 NKJV

(d) Serve Yahweh and He will bless you with many children and long lives.

- you shall drive them out before you." Exodus 23:31 NKJV
- (4) Do not make friends with your enemies nor let them cohabitate with you. The desire to live like them and play with their false gods will be too tempting!
 - (a) "You shall make no covenant with them, nor with their gods. They shall not dwell in your land, lest they make you sin against Me. For if you serve their gods, it will surely be a snare to you."" Exodus 23:32-33 NKJV

But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their

senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

Hebrews 5:12-14 NKJV

 - 3. This little by little concept is so important that I will reiterate it Deuteronomy.
 - 4. I will indeed hand over your enemies...
 - 5. When I do, do not make friends with your enemies nor let them cohabitate with you. The desire to live like them and play with their false gods will be too tempting!
 - 6. To become mature, it will be a step-by-step process. You will start off drinking milk, like a baby. Babies understand very little. But as you grow, you will be able to handle more and more. If you try to digest too much at too young an age, when you are not ready, you will choke!

(2) Milk to Meat

- (a) "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now." John 16:12
 - 1. Becoming mature is a step-by-step process like a child that grows into an adult over time, with all the stages in between. But, sometimes you remain a child too long and have to stay on mother's milk when you should be able to chew solid food! The solid food is the deep understanding of God's word culminating with a proper understand of good and evil!

C. I Do #2

- (1) Are you really sure?
 - (a) The people affirm their "I do!" a second time! "So Moses came and told the people all the words of the Lord and all the judgments. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words which the Lord has said we will do."" Exodus 24:3 NKJV
- (2) The Shedding of Blood
 - (a) Blood to ratify the agreement! "And Moses wrote all the words of the Lord. And he rose early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain, and twelve pillars according to the twelve tribes of Israel. Then he sent young men of the children of Israel, who offered burnt offerings and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen to the Lord. And Moses took half the blood and

put it in basins, and half the blood he sprinkled on the altar." Exodus 24:4-6 NKJV

- (3) Every Covenant requires blood! For where there is a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. Not even the first covenant was dedicated without blood. And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.
 - (a) The Shadow! "For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance. For where there is a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. For a testament is in force after men are dead, since it has no power at all while the testator lives. Therefore not even the first covenant was dedicated without blood. For when Moses had

spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water, scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people, saying, "This is the blood of the covenant which God has commanded you." Then likewise he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry. And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.

Therefore it was necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these." Hebrews 9:13-23 NKJV

D. 1 Do #3

And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. The sight of the glory of the Lord was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.
