From where do you derive your value? Pay close attention here; I'm not asking you from where you derive your values, as in principles and standards of behavior. I'm asking about your selfworth. It's easy to fall into the trap that defines you as your profession or vocation; your possessions, position and accomplishments; your situation and circumstances; relationships and associations; your true outer appearance or how you appear to others, including their opinions, judgments, gossip, posts and compliments. Even your divine calling and purpose is not who you are, is not how your real worth is measured.

Many people today are victims of selfie-worth, an inner belief that you are what you can convince others to believe about you. I am not sure that's any better than those who feel they have no worth at all. Any combination of these valuation formulas is a lie, and we know who fathers lies! Yet, if you are not any of these, what are you? Who are you? How much are you worth and who decides? These are all excellent questions, and if you are not asking them, maybe you should be!

I'd like to introduce you to a concept. Those who are not bornagain, justified by faith in the precious work of the cross of Christ, have at their disposal a sole self-valuation formula that demands they load their balance-sheet with self-worth assets derived from the above. Christians, however, have a different form of accounting at their disposal, should they choose. Yes, it's available, but not guaranteed. You must exercise the option.

Sure, at your born-again encounter, you confessed who God is and what Y'shua had done for you. In other words you openly acknowledged with your mouth that God is who He says He is. But, there is another side to the faith coin, and that is the belief in your heart that you are who God says you are. And that is the optional side. You can believe who God is and yet your opinion of yourself can still be wrapped up in all of the above lies. The cross-over happens when you abandon those lies and begin to see your self-worth through God's eyes. Yes! He is from where your real valuation comes. The High Priest of our confession sets the true value of people, places and things, and I highly suggest you adopt His accounting method!

# Let's Set the Scene: Portion in a blurb

1. This Portion promises blessings and rewards for Israel if they will keep the Torah, but punishment and curses if they break the commandments of the Torah. The last chapter discusses laws pertaining to vows, valuations and tithes.

#### **Leviticus 26**

- 2. **Promise of Blessing and Retribution:** Here we have similar promises for obedience and disobedience as we see in Deuteronomy 28.
  - (a) Technically the first two verses of Leviticus 26 belong to last week's portion but they are a great introduction to this week's reading: "You shall not make idols for yourselves; neither a carved image nor a sacred pillar shall you rear up for yourselves; nor shall you set up an engraved stone in your land, to bow down to it; for I am the Lord your God. You shall

- keep My Sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary: I am the Lord." Leviticus 26:1-2 NKJV
- 3. **Obedience** brings rain in its season and all sorts of abundance, peace and protection from evil.
  - (a) Yahweh will set His **tabernacle among the people. He** will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people. (See Paul's take on this.)
- 4. **But if you do not obey Me,** and do not observe all these commandments this is what you get:
  - (a) Disease, plagues, defeat, desolation, and vengeance. He will break the pride of your power; your land shall not yield its produce; He will destroy your high places and cut down your incense altars; He will scatter you among the nations and your land shall be desolate and your cities wasted; You shall perish among the nations.
- 5. **But if you repent:** confess your iniquity and the iniquity of your fathers, with your unfaithfulness and that you have walked contrary to Me, and *humble your* uncircumcised hearts, and you accept your guilt—then He will remember His covenant.
- 6. Yet for all that, He will not cast you away, nor utterly destroy you nor break His covenant with you; But, for your sake He will remember the covenant of your ancestors, whom He brought

out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that He might be your God.

#### **Leviticus 27**

### 7. Redeeming Persons and Property Dedicated to God:

Valuations for all ages of people and rules for the poor are set. Valuations and redemption costs and rules for all animal offerings, unclean animals, houses, land, fields, and various ownership rights and how they relate to the Jubilee are set down, as well as rules and values for firstborn animals. Every devoted offering is most holy to the Lord.

- 8. No person under the ban, who may become doomed to destruction among men, shall be redeemed, *but* shall surely be put to death.
- 9. Rules for tithes of the land, seeds and animals are discussed.
- 10. You can study the last two year's teachings here. In both past years they were taught as double portions, which included Leviticus 25: The Tale of Two Prepositions & Raven and Lilies

# 1. What are you worth?

# A. The priest shall set a value...

- (1) A Sound Mind: the mind of Christ
  - (a) The tools you have at your disposal, should you choose to access them, consist of: **Power**, or in other words, the supernatural empowerment of God's grace; **Love**, or in other words, the expression of God's divine nature; and a **Sound Mind**, or in other words, the mind of Christ.
    - "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power [the seeds] and of love [the house] and of a sound mind [the people]." II Timothy 1:7 NKJV
  - (b) We have been preserved for a special calling that has nothing to do with what we deserve or can earn on our own. Instead, the value we bring into the world is determined by God and is completely empowered by Him.
    - 1. "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God, who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in

Christ Jesus before time began, but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel," II Timothy 1:8-10 NKJV

- (c) The ministration of each of these tools has an expression into the earth: we preach to plant seeds and within that seed is the explosive genetic code of multiplication. We become the expression of God's divine nature as pioneers (apostles) into a lost world. And we impart (teach) wisdom and knowledge to transform minds.
  - 1. "to which I was appointed a **preacher** [power to plant seeds], an **apostle** [the mission to become love], and a **teacher** [the teacher of sound doctrine] of the Gentiles." II Timothy 1:11 NKJV
- (2) Look to priest for your true value!
  - (a) We are immediately confronted with this question: who determines your value? And if we peer just below the surface, we discover that it is only our value to Yahweh that matters.
    - 1. "Now the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When a man

# consecrates by a vow certain persons to the Lord, according to your valuation," Leviticus 27:1-2 NKJV

- (b) As we come before the priest, we are essentially broke if we are measured by others. So, in total humility and submission, we look to the priest to define our true worth!
  - 1. "But if he is too poor to pay your valuation, then he shall present himself before the priest, and the priest shall set a value for him; according to the ability of him who vowed, the priest shall value him."

Leviticus 27:8 NKJV

- (3) Coming before our High Priest
  - (a) The Priest Knows your Value. Each person or thing has an inherent value if we just measure them or it in isolation. Break down the parts and place them in a balance sheet. Assign each part a value and then total them for a final estimate. However, when we belong to God, there is another factor involved, the maker or builder assigns the true value to His creation. The value of a piece of canvas and some paints is one thing, but when those paints are arranged on the canvas by Michelangelo, then those parts are no longer worth what they cost from the art supply store. They are now

- worth something immeasurably more because of He who arranged them!
- 1. "Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house. For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house. For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is God. And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward, but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end." Hebrews 3:1-6 NKJV

### B. <u>His Workmanship</u>

- (1) A thing made, a work, workmanship, fabric...
  - (a) You were dead and made alive...at one point, all you were worth was the sum of your parts. For humans, that's about six dollars worth of minerals, 15 gallons worth of free water, and cost of the energy to bring that 15 gallons of water to a boil. Let's say in today's energy

costs that about one dollar. So, in raw materials you are worth about seven bucks!

- 1. "And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that **not of yourselves;** it is the gift of God, **not of works**, lest anyone should boast." Ephesians 2:1-9 NKJV
- (b) However, Yahweh is your Michelangelo, and He has assigned your actual value. As we saw a moment ago,

"We have been preserved for a special calling that has nothing to do with what we deserve or can earn on our own. Instead, the value we bring into the world is determined by God and is completely empowered by Him." Yahweh has prepared us for an assignment and that is what determines our true value! He is the master craftsmen who has created you as a priceless work of art! Read Proverbs 8 and you come to realize that Christ is the master craftsman (the artist) who created you! "Then I was beside Him as a master craftsman; And I was daily His delight, Rejoicing always before Him," Proverbs 8:30 NKJV

- 1. "For we are **His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God **prepared beforehand** that we should walk in them." Ephesians 2:10 NKJV
- (c) Yes, at creation, we were His greatest handiwork. The invisible attributes of God Himself, man created in His image, was His greatest workmanship. What is that worth?
  - "For since the creation of the world His invisible
     attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the
     things that are made [His workmanship: Adam and
     Eve—see Image of God], even His eternal power and

- Godhead, so that they are without excuse," Romans 1:20 NKJV
- a) See <u>The Image of God</u> for an expanded teaching on God's invisible qualities!
- (d) Let's get personal. What is God's artwork? Who is God's artwork? He knew you before He formed you in your mother's womb. Before the foundation of the earth He knew you, sanctified you (gave you a holy calling— II Timothy 1:8-10), and ordained you (assigned your ministry— II Timothy 1:11)! You will go where He sends you without fear (II Timothy 1:7) and speak (preach and teach). He has put His words in your mouth! You will transform nations. You will root out, pull down destroy and throw down all that opposes God. And you will build and plant seeds of the Kingdom! (Now—go back and read II Timothy 1:7-11!)
  - "Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying:

    "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you;

    Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations." Then said I: "Ah, Lord God! Behold, I cannot speak, for I am a youth." But the Lord said to me: "Do not say, 'I am a youth,' For you shall go to all to whom I send you, And

whatever I command you, you shall speak. Do not be afraid of their faces, For I am with you to deliver you," says the Lord. Then the Lord put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the Lord said to me: "Behold, I have put My words in your mouth. See, I have this day set you over the nations and over the kingdoms, To root out and to pull down, To destroy and to throw down, To build and to plant."" Jeremiah 1:4-10 NKJV

- 2. I love how Y'shua words it! Don't worry about what to say when you face leaders; the Holy Spirit will touch your mouth!
  - 1. ""Now when they bring you to the synagogues and magistrates and authorities, do not worry about how or what you should answer, or what you should say. For the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say."" Luke 12:11-12 NKJV
- (2) His valuation system...
  - (a) Let's zoom into the paint on the canvas. What exactly are you made of?
    - 1. "O Lord, **You have searched me and known me.** You know my sitting down and my rising up; You

understand my thought afar off. You comprehend my path and my lying down, And are acquainted with all my ways. For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O Lord, You know it altogether. You have hedged me behind and before, **And laid Your hand** upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot attain it. Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, Even there Your hand shall lead me, And **Your right hand shall hold me.** If I say, "Surely the darkness shall fall on me," Even the night shall be light about me; Indeed, the darkness shall not hide **from You,** But the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light are both alike to You. For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well. **My frame was not hidden from You,** When I was made in secret, And

skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth." Psalms 139:1-15 NKJV

- 1. "Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed.

  And in Your book they all were written, The days fashioned for me, When as yet there were none of them. How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; When I awake, I am still with You." Psalms 139:16-18 NKJV
- (c) "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he." (Proverbs 23:7)

  Fix your thinking! If at any point in time you become anxious, it is simply because you don't know these things or have forgotten them. "Lord, do some heart surgery on them and fix their stinking thinking as needed!"
  - "Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting."
     Psalms 139:23-24 NKJV
- (d) I love how Y'shua makes things so simple. How valuable are you? Birds live with zero anxieties about who they are; why they were created; what they should do; and how they will be provided for. And they are just birds!

 "Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?" Matthew 6:26-27 NKJV

# C. His accounting system, not yours...

- (1) What does He think of us?
  - (a) The easy side of our born-again experience is the supernatural realization of who God is and who is our savior. The more difficult part is to change our stinking thinking about who we are! We must conform into who God says we are to be! This must be practiced by taking every thought captive and bringing it into alignment with the mind of Christ!
    - 1. "that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness [how God sees you], and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation [what Christ did for you]." Romans 10:9-10 NKJV
    - 2. "casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, **bringing**

# every thought into captivity to the obedience of **Christ,**" II Corinthians 10:5 NKJV

- (b) At first, bringing every thought into alignment with the mind of Christ might seem impossible, as His thoughts are so above ours, however...
  - 1. ""For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the Lord. "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts." Isaiah 55:8-9 NKJV
- (c) We have at our disposal, access to a new way of thinking...
  - "For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ."
     I Corinthians 2:16 NKJV
- (2) Again...what has He give us?
  - (a) The tools you have at your disposal, should you choose to access them, consist of: **Power**, or in other words, the supernatural empowerment of God's grace; **Love**, or in other words, the expression of God's divine nature; and a **Sound Mind**, or in other words, the mind of Christ.
    - 1. "Therefore I remind you to **stir up the gift** of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

- For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of **power** [things, seeds, preacher] and of **love** and of a **sound mind**." II Timothy 1:6-7 NKJV
- (b) The ministration of each of these tools has an expression into the earth: we preach to plant seeds and within that seed is the explosive genetic code of multiplication. We become the expression of God's divine nature as pioneers (apostles) into a lost world. And we impart (teach) wisdom and knowledge to transform minds.
  - 1. "to which I was appointed a preacher [power to plant seeds], an apostle [the mission to become love], and a teacher [the teacher of sound doctrine] of the Gentiles." II Timothy 1:11 NKJV
- (c) What are you lacking? Northing!
  - "as His divine power has given to us all things that
     pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge
     of Him who called us by glory and virtue," II Peter
     1:3 NKJV
  - 2. "But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be **perfect and complete, lacking nothing**." James 1:4 NKJV
- (d) What should get in you way? Nothing!

- 1. "For I am persuaded that **neither** death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, **nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus** our Lord." Romans 8:38-39 NKJV
- (3) This is what you were without Him!
  - (a) A Filthy Rag...
    - 1. "For since the beginning of the world Men have not heard nor perceived by the ear, Nor has the eye seen any God besides You, Who acts for the one who waits for Him. You meet him who rejoices and does righteousness, Who remembers You in Your ways. You are indeed angry, for we have sinned— In these ways we continue; And we need to be saved. But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away." Isaiah 64:4-6 NKJV
  - (b) Even the best the world has to offer without Him is rubbish compared to life with Him!
    - 1. "though I also might have confidence in the flesh. If anyone else thinks he may have confidence in the

flesh, I more so: ...But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;" Philippians 3:4, 7-9 NKJV

- (c) Without Him...no one is righteous; no one understands; no one seeks Him; no one follows Him; no one does a single valuable thing; no one has anything good to say...
  - 1. "What then? Are we better than they? Not at all. For we have previously charged both Jews and Greeks that they are all under sin. As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God. They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one." "Their throat is an open tomb; With their tongues they have practiced deceit"; "The

poison of asps is under their lips"; "Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness." "Their feet are swift to shed blood; Destruction and misery are in their ways; And the way of peace they have not known." "There is no fear of God before their eyes." Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin." Romans 3:9-20 NKJV

- (d) Everyone, apart from Him is condemned by sin; and in Him alone is grace and redemption. So, if you are nothing without Him, then what are you with Him?
  - 1. "But now the **righteousness of God** apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference; **for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God**, **being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus**," Romans 3:21-24 NKJV

- (4) This is what you are with Him! Justified...it's more than you think!
  - (a) Justified! You have entered a new accounting system. It does not matter if the numbers from your old life add up. You now have an accountant who, not only balances your debits and credits, but He leaves you with an over-abundance of expendable resources, the best of all being the asset of Grace (access to God's supernatural Power!)
    - 1. "Therefore, having been **justified by faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have **access by faith into this grace** in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God." Romans 5:1-2 NKJV
  - (b) Fear not...this transaction takes place without any need for your involvement. However, your involvement is required after the transaction takes place!
    - 1. "For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more

then, having now been **justified by His blood**, we shall be **saved from wrath through Him.**" Romans 5:6-9 NKJV

- (b) His valuation system! God saw the sum of your entire being before you ever lived one day, and He has ordained every one of those days in advance! You are the product of the precious thoughts of the infinite Creator of the universe!

- (c) "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he." (Proverbs 23:7)

  Fix your thinking! If at any point in time you become anxious, it is simply because you don't know these things or have forgotten them. "Lord, do some heart surgery on them and fix their stinking thinking as needed!"
- (d) I love how Y'shua makes things so simple. How valuable are you? Birds live with zero anxieties about who they are; why they were created; what they should do; and how they will be provided for. And they are just birds!

### C. His accounting system, not yours...

- (1) What does He think of us?
  - (a) The easy side of our born-again experience is the supernatural realization of who God is and who is our savior. The more difficult part is to change our stinking thinking about who we are! We must conform into who God says we are to be! This must be practiced by taking every thought captive and bringing it into alignment with the mind of Christ!
  - (b) At first, bringing every thought into alignment with the mind of Christ might seem impossible, as His thoughts are so above ours, however...

- (c) We have at our disposal, access to a new way of thinking...
- (2) Again...what has He give us?
  - (a) The tools you have at your disposal, should you choose to access them, consist of: **Power**, or in other words, the supernatural empowerment of God's grace; **Love**, or in other words, the expression of God's divine nature; and a **Sound Mind**, or in other words, the mind of Christ.
  - (b) The ministration of each of these tools has an expression into the earth: we preach to plant seeds and within that seed is the explosive genetic code of multiplication. We become the expression of God's divine nature as pioneers (apostles) into a lost world. And we impart (teach) wisdom and knowledge to transform minds.
  - (c) What are you lacking? Northing!
  - (d) What should get in you way? Nothing!
- (3) This is what you were without Him!
  - (a) A Filthy Rag...
  - (b) Even the best the world has to offer without Him is rubbish compared to life with Him!
  - (c) Without Him...no one is righteous; no one understands; no one seeks Him; no one follows Him; no one does a

- single valuable thing; no one has anything good to say...
- (d) Everyone, apart from Him is condemned by sin; and in Him alone is grace and redemption. So, if you are nothing without Him, then what are you with Him?
- (4) This is what you are with Him! Justified...it's more than you think!
  - (a) Justified! You have entered a new accounting system. It does not matter if the numbers from your old add up. You now have an accountant who, not only balances your debits and credits, but He leaves you with an overabundance of expendable resources, the best of all being the asset of Grace (access to God's supernatural Power!)
  - (b) Fear not...this transaction takes place without any need for your involvement. However, your involvement is required after the transaction takes place!

#### 2. Love

## A. As the priest values, so it shall stand...

- (1) Love: God is Love; therefore you should be love!
  - (a) The tools you have at your disposal, should you choose to access them, consist of: **Power**, or in other words, the supernatural empowerment of God's grace; **Love**, or in other words, the expression of God's divine nature; and a **Sound Mind**, or in other words, the mind of Christ.
    - "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power [the seeds] and of love [the house] and of a sound mind [the people]." II Timothy 1:7 NKJV
  - (b) We have been preserved for a special calling that has nothing to do with what we deserve or can earn on our own. Instead, the value we bring into the world is determined by God and is completely empowered by Him.
    - 1. "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God, who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in

- Christ Jesus before time began, but has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel," II Timothy 1:8-10 NKJV
- (c) The ministration of each of these tools has an expression into the earth: we preach to plant seeds and within that seed is the explosive genetic code of multiplication. We become the expression of God's divine nature as pioneers (apostles) into a lost world. And we impart (teach) wisdom and knowledge to transform minds.
  - 1. "to which I was appointed a **preacher** [power to plant seeds], an **apostle** [the mission to become love], and a **teacher** [the teacher of sound doctrine] of the Gentiles." II Timothy 1:11 NKJV
- (2) You are His House
  - (a) **Love:** the expression of God's divine nature
    - 1. "'And when a man dedicates his house to be holy to the Lord, then the priest shall set a value for it, whether it is good or bad; as the priest values it, so it shall stand." Leviticus 27:14 NKJV
- (3) Reminder: The Priest sets your value...

- (a) Each person or thing has an inherent value if we just measure them or it in isolation. Break down the parts and place them in a balance sheet. Assign each part a value and then add them up for a final estimate. However, when we belong to God, there is another factor involved, the maker or builder assigns the true value to His creation. The value of a piece of canvas and some paints is one thing, but when those paints are arranged on the canvas by Michelangelo, then those parts are no longer worth what they cost from the art supply store. They are now worth something immeasurably more because of He who arranged them!
  - 1. "Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house. For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house. For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is God. And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward, but Christ as a

**Son over His own house, whose house we are** if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end." Hebrews 3:1-6 NKJV

#### B. Whose house we are...

- (1) God's Building; God's Temple; God's Ambassadors
  - (a) We are God's holy edifice. The Spirit of God dwells in us as God's house, so our house can be the expression of God's love into the earth! We are His ambassadors who are carrying God's righteousness into the world.
    - 1. "For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building. According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it. For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will suffer loss; but he

not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are." I Corinthians 3:9-17 NKJV

- 2. "Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? Certainly not! Or do you not know that he who is joined to a harlot is one body with her? For "the two," He says, "shall become one flesh." But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him. Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's." I Corinthians 6:15-20 NKJV
- 3. "Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. For He

made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." II Corinthians 5:20-21 NKJV

# A. Your land is only as valuable as the seeds you plant on it...

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  - (b) We have been preserved for a special calling that has nothing to do with what we deserve or can earn on our own. Instead, the value we bring into the world is determined by God and is completely empowered by Him.
    - 1. "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God, who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in

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  - 1. "to which I was appointed a **preacher** [power to plant seeds], an **apostle** [the mission to become love], and a **teacher** [the teacher of sound doctrine] of the Gentiles." II Timothy 1:11 NKJV
- (2) You are His multiplication
  - (a) Seeds: you have in you the DNA of God. Go plant it!
    - "'If a man dedicates to the Lord part of a field of his possession, then your valuation shall be according to the seed for it. A homer of barley seed shall be valued at fifty shekels of silver." Leviticus 27:16 NKJV
- B. Seeds: more than you can ask of imagine

- (1) You can count the seeds in an apple, but you cannot count the apples in a seed!
  - (a) Seedtime and harvest is God's business plan!
    - ""While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest,
      Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and
      night Shall not cease."" Genesis 8:22 NKJV
  - (b) Seeds will not produce a harvest unless they die first!

    What might that mean about you? To serve Him, you
    must die to all you used to be. But fear not, the harvest
    is immeasurable!
    - 1. "But Jesus answered them, saying, "The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor." John 12:23-26 NKJV
  - (c) If you are willing to sow your seed, He is ready to provide your seed. If you sow a little, you get a little. If you sow it all, you get it all!

"But this I say: **He who sows sparingly will also reap** sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." Now may He who supplies seed to **the sower,** and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God. For the administration of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God, while, through the proof of this ministry, they glorify God for the obedience of your confession to the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal sharing with them and all men, and by their prayer for you, who long for you because of the

- exceeding grace of God in you. Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!" II Corinthians 9:6-15 NKJV
- (d) And let's be clear here. The multiplication is all about God. Yes, we plant and we water, but if God had not placed His DNA in the seed, nothing would happen!
  - 1. "Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor." I Corinthians 3:5-8 NKIV

### C. Power of seed

- (1) Plant your seed!
  - (a) The power of God's DNA in your seeds is the same power that raised Christ from the Grave!
    - "and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places," Ephesians 1:19-20 NKJV

## (2) The Harvest

- (a) According to His glory, you will be filled with His Spirit. You will be rooted and grounded in love, a love so multi-dimensional that it produces precisely what God promised in Jeremiah 1:4-10 (You will root out, pull down destroy and throw down all that opposes God. And you will build and plant seeds of the Kingdom!). The results will be beyond what your human brain can comprehend. And if you can imagine it, it is exceedingly more than that!
  - 1. "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according

**to the power that works in us,** to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." Ephesians 3:14-21 NKJV

- (3) Never stop planting
  - (a) Don't grow tired when you feel your planting is not producing the harvest you expect. God's seeds ALWAYS produce God's offspring!
    - 1. "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart." Galatians 6:7-9 NKJV

# D. What are you planting?

- (1) Notes about the types of seeds you plant...
  - (a) Don't use bad seed. Bad seed produces bad fruit. If all you desire is what the world can offer, then plant earth DNA. If you want the Kingdom of Heaven, plant heaven DNA!
    - 1. ""Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in

**heaven**, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Matthew 6:19-21 NKJV

- 2. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble." Matthew 6:33-34 NKJV
- (2) Don't forget the fertilizer...
  - (a) Whatever you do, do as unto the lord and the harvest will always be supernatural.
    - 1. "And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ." Colossians 3:23-24 NKJV

### E. Soil Matters!

- (1) What are you planting in...(Read the Parable of the soils: Matthew 13:1-23)
  - (a) Bad seed in good soil yields bad fruit. Good seed in bad soil yields bad fruit. Good seed in good soil yields good fruit.

- 1. "Then He spoke many things to them in parables, saying: "Behold, a sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them. Some fell on stony places, where they did not have much earth; and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up and choked them. But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"" Matthew 13:3-9 NKJV
- 2. "When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside. But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles. Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who

hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful. But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.""

Matthew 13:19-23 NKJV

## F. Good SEEDS in GOOD SOIL

- (1) The question is not how many seeds are in an apple but how many apples are in a seed.
  - (a) Go Make Disciples...
    - 1. "Go therefore and **make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen." Matthew 28:19-20 NKJV
  - (b) A disciple of Christ is one who is being discipled to make disciples who can make disciples...
    - "And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also." II Timothy 2:2 NKJV

- (c) Take up your cross and count the cost...Seeds must die to multiply their DNA!
  - "Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me." Luke 9:23 NKJV
  - 2. ""If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple. And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it —...So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple." Luke 14:26-28, 33 NKJV
- (d) Approved workers rightly dividing the word of truth ...
  - "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." II Timothy 2:15 NKJV
