Blessing

God did not create the world to be without form and void, yet already within the very first book of the Bible in the very first chapter illustrated for us in the second verse it says that the earth came to be without form and void shortly after its inception!

Cause and Effect

In the Physical World (the Earth) we have the idea of Cause and Effect, and in the Spiritual World (the Heavens) the true source of this scientific principle, Cause and Effect, is God's Intention (the cause) inevitably followed by God's Blessing (the effect). The adversary also imitates by creating a corrupted cause and effect as well. It is my hope that in uncovering this mystery together and how it works, we may began to understand what we must do as One Body to finish the job. Hence the title!

"For this is what the LORD says— he who created the heavens, he is God; he who fashioned and made the earth, he founded it; he did not create it to be empty, but formed it to be inhabited— he says: "I am the LORD, and there is no other."

1. The Essence of Evil

A. False Religion à la Man as Authority Over Everything

- (1) Atheism a lack of belief or a strong disbelief in God
 - (a) The false religion of Atheism is surprisingly old and older than King David's era as it is referenced in the Book of Psalms chapter 15.
 - 1. The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good. **Psalm 14:1**
- (2) Futility (meaning uselessness)
 - (a) When an individual (created in the image of God) chooses to live his life powered by a belief system based on infinite meaninglessness, a tremendous amount of

effort and energy is being used (all of it) to try to get nowhere fast for no reason at all, and he doesn't have the Spiritual wherewithal to even begin to notice. Dr. Jeff calls this the act of dissipation.

- "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding" Proverbs 9:10
- 2. "Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and that day will not come on you suddenly like a trap; for it will come upon all those who dwell on the face of all the earth."

Luke 21:35

B. The Parasite

- (1) An analogy using the awful design of the parasite offers an enlightening incite into the essence of evil.
 - (a) The duty of the parasite is to steal, kill, and destroy. It attaches itself to a living host, which could be an individual or even a dying world. Whatever the individual consumes goes straight to the parasite without adding one iota of benefit to the consumer.

1. "Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour."

1 Peter 5:8

- a) It's no surprise after learning from the likes of Dr.

 Jeff and many Holistic dietitians/physicians that the health care industry as it stands today is a for profit industry. Thus reciprocating the truth embedded within the verse above.
- b) In order to escape the trap of the parasite, whether it be emotional, spiritual or physical, one must take matters into God's hand, and single-mindedly ask for His help to stay sharp amidst the lures of the World backed by the forces of Hell and their lullaby traps of eternal doom.

C. A Meaningless Death

- (1) "It was all futile, evil, a chasing after the wind, a fractionally flatulent blip during a hurricane."
 - (a) A human being can seemingly obtain a great number of accomplishments within a finite space and time (*vast fortune, fame and notoriety, progeny, Nobel prizes, bells and whistles, etc.*), but if he has no reason for being here which involves an authentic belief in and

relationship with the God of Abraham, Issac and Jacob – everything a human being does only benefits the parasite which is to say *nothing and no one*. We can reference the entire book of Ecclesiastes as the biblical source for this reasoning.

2. The Journey: God's Gift to the World.

A. A Taste of Heaven and A Taste of Hell

- (1) What does it mean that God created man and woman in His image?
 - (a) Since God has the freedom to do whatever He wills, so He gave man the freedom to do whatever he wills.
 - (b) Because God loves us and because His love is not biased and is independent of such lowly humanistic tactics such as bribery or flattery He gives every man regardless of religion, political bias, gender, ethnicity, or sexual preference an opportunity to experience the blessing of life as heaven on earth, and the curse of death as hell on earth.
 - 1. "See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. For I command you today to love the Lord your God, to walk in obedience to him, and to keep his commands,

decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess. But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed...

Deuteronomy 30:15-18ish

2. "...He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous."

Matthew 5:45

B. God's Children vs. Mankind

- (1) The Saints
 - (a) God's Children are those who are called by Y'shua and hear His voice. They have a special mission in God's plan to restore the Earth.
 - 1. "For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed. For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the

children of God."

Romans 8:19-20

2. "So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him. Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom the master has put in charge of the servants in his household to give them their food at the proper time?"

Matthew 24:45-46

- a) Just as Joseph was placed in charge to govern the Kingdom of Egypt, so too will the Children of God be granted the responsibility to take charge of the whole world.
- b) Clearly, there must needs be a group of people living in the World for the Children of God to rule over the servants of the Household: "We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat." Hebrews 13:10
- (2) Mankind (The Servants of the Household)
 - (a) There is another group that is waiting and anticipating God's voice to lead them: Mankind.

1. "What is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them? You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet: all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild, the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas."

Psalm 8:4-8

a) God created a world that is always supposed to be, and a flesh and blood human species that is always meant to remain on the earth. These people are with us today, and they believe in the same God we do, however they have a different mission and a lesser covenant. Because of their faithfulness and reverence it is God's will that they should be resuscitated in the world to come (more on this later):

"And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. **Hebrews 13:6**;

"Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness." **Genesis 15:16**

- (3) Joseph the Dreamer vs. the Commoners
 - (a) After many years of trial and sufferings, Joseph received favor in the eyes of God and Man. As a result, Pharaoh placed him in charge of the World (Egypt).
 - (b) The brothers of Joseph who sold him off to slavery didn't recognize him when they came to Egypt to buy grain. Actually, the reverse image of the same story is in the works today and for the past two-thousand years. A tale as old as time; a dispute between rivaling siblings, Faithful Jews (the other ten sons of Jacob) vs. Faithful Christians (Joseph).
 - (c) Faithful Jews had/have a hard time recognizing their Brother Y'shua as Messiah. Surprisingly, they can not apprehend to the fullest degree the meaning behind Christianity's impact across the globe for the past two thousand years, and much of that is our fault.
 - (d) Modern day History: the story of the rise Christianity vs. Judaism is the Story of Joseph vs. his ten older brothers in reverse.

- a) Instead of the brothers persecuting Joseph in the beginning of the story, we have had Joseph (Christians) persecuting the Jews near the beginning during the worldwide rise of Christianity.
- b) The Brothers were born under the same roof as
 Joseph and grew up knowing him intimately, and
 after a season of time in which Joseph was sold
 into slavery and came to be in Egypt his brothers
 didn't recognize him. Conversely, the brothers
 today in modern History and beyond (Faithful
 Jews) are born apart from their Christians siblings,
 they don't recognize their younger brother, Joseph
 now, but they will very soon! When they finally do
 we will all come to live under the same roof, but
 this time in a glorified position of eternal honor.
- (4) What are Jews looking forward to in the life to come?
 - (a) Judaism has no use for heaven. They foresee a return to the Garden of Eden, and the complete restoration of their nation, the Kingdom of Israel with the rightful King David ruling over their Garden for the rest of eternity.

(b) Their Messiah must come to restore everything. We now know that they are waiting for Joseph, who would be completely mature, Christlike people that minister to the earth during the millennial kingdom.

3. God's Intention is followed by God's Eternal Blessing

A. Long Story in Short Form

- (1) The Kingdom of Heaven cannot come to Earth without the Earth becoming first becoming fully restored.
 - (a) God originally designed the Earth to be in sync with Heaven. He saw all that He made Heaven and Earth and they were BOTH very good (Genesis 1:31). In other words, you cannot have one without the other.
 - 1. "For this is what the LORD says— he who created the heavens, he is God; he who fashioned and made the earth, he founded it; he did not create it to be empty, but formed it to be inhabited— he says: "I am the LORD, and there is no other." Isaiah 45:18
 - 2. "Generations come and generations go, but the earth remains forever." **Ecclesiastes 1:4**

3. "Your faithfulness continues through all generations; you established the earth, and it endures. **Psalm**119:90

(2) God always uses (2) counterparts to get a job done:

- (a) We have God the Father, YHVH, and His counterpart, the Holy Spirt.
- (b) You have Man and His Wife; in which the image of God is seen in the physical realm.
- (c) You have Israel, and the (70) nations; with which *God's version* of the United Nations functions on Earth, and as a bonus, it serves as a handy visual for the spiritual difference between the Heavenly Israel and the Earthly Israel.
- (d) You have Aaron and Moses serving as God's key people who work together to fulfill prophecy. Aaron representing Faithful Jews, and Moses representing the Body of Y'shua.
 - 1. "He poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's head and anointed him to consecrate him."

 Leviticus 8:12
 - 2. "Comfort, comfort my people, says your God."

 Isaiah 40:1

(e) In the New Testament you have John the Baptizer, and Y'shua HaMaschaich.
