A. The Sheep and The Goats

Matt. 25:31-46 Context:

Yahshua is speaking about himself in future tense, using language that appears metaphoric.

31. When I comes back I will judge and rule the earth

32. All people will submit to me, and I will judge all people
33. I will put my love in my right hand and my hate in my left
deciding which to use
34. "Come those who believe and walked worthy of the calling,
here is what I promised you."
35. You were generous to me when I was in need
36. You showed kindness when no one else did
37-39. Implies an expression of humility through denying
having any affect on Yahshua himself
40. My love strikes so deep that whichever you do for another
human, as every single one was made in my image, then you

What is it like to watch someone you love suffer? Can you
imagine the pain In Yahshua's heart when people choose sin
and death over peace, joy, and life.

(1 Timothy 2:1-10) Yahshua clearly wants all people to be saved,
that's why he laid his life down. What about the pain in the
Fathers heart, the One Who created you.

In (Genesis 1:27) Yahweh created mankind in His own image,
no different than you and I being birthed from our parents. If

you have a child then you truly know what it's like to have your own flesh and blood stand before you. In the same way, we all stand seen before Yahweh who is the Father over all of life. In this expression of Yahshua I believe we are more than just wanted by him, we are needed, desired. It's clear human beings are constantly in need ourselves and it's a fact that Yahweh fills those who He loves. It's our job to mimic Yahweh and lend a hand to others, Yahshua showed us how, for whatever we do unto others we do unto Him. Yahshua would have no ultimate purpose if we did not obey him in this life. He came to show us there was only one way into the Kingdom, obey. His sacrifice would be in vain if we don't. Our very own king is thirsty, will you give him a drink that quenches his thirst? Obedience is like Incense, a pleasing aroma, and offerings to Yahweh it arouses His joy and causes blessings to come upon us in this life and the next.

B. There is No Want in Those Who Seek You
(Needs and wants)

Psalms 34 Context:

The children of Yahweh can do nothing of themselves, they absolutely need help and understand it comes from Them.

Do you know what it means to be desperate for Yahweh? To so deeply desire Him that you quite literally can't continue on without His intervention in your life. Needing Yahweh is the exact same as being dehydrated and thirsty for water. It's life or death.

When was the last time you needed something? Most likely it was less than a few hours ago, or even minutes, when you took that first sip of water for the day. It's quite obvious you need water because without it you would die of dehydration.

Hopefully everybody knows that to be true. At some point in your life, you may have experienced the bizarre feelings of dehydration. In the moment nothing makes sense, your vision fogs up, your hands and feet get pins and needles, and the worst of all is when you feel nauseous as if you're going to pass out. It's a total nightmare! You know having just one sip of water would cure all these symptoms. There is no doubt about what you need when you are dehydrated. When was the last time you wanted something? Maybe it was this morning in the car glancing at a coffee shop, or a Mercedes Benz dealership, or a shoe store. You would definitely not die if you continued driving by without stopping for those things. Wanting is not a matter of life and death. Wanting something is a desire to possess something, usually material items, or even to be accepted by others. We all want a good name, good health, and a nice fortune, but do you need any of those things to truly be alive?

It's clear there are vast differences between needing something and wanting something:

- A need is necessary for life, and a want is when you have the desire to possess something.
- Needs are things you absolutely should have, and wants are things you would like to have.

- Needing something is often an expression of desperation, you are willing to do what you must to attain it.
- Wanting something is usually done in a leisurely manner, its efforts are relaxing and comfortable.

Wanting a relationship with Yahweh in comparison to needing one is not bad thing, that's not the takeaway! Matter of fact, wanting Him is just as good as needing Him, each position bares fruit. Wanting Yahweh is the starting point of our journey in faith. We all should want Yahweh to be near, this is why we make efforts everyday to obey Him, In hopes that obedience will build relationship and increase love. (If you love me you'll do what I say). It's called having faith, the connection of His mind and ours through a process of trust. Keep in mind there is a difference between needing and wanting Yahweh and we should know what the difference is.

Needing a relationship with Yahweh often comes from a place of desperation. You've hit a rock bottom, you know what scarring pain is, and you possibly couldn't live another day without His presence because of how much you depend on Him for every breathe. Needing Yahweh is like needing water, It's a very dramatic occurrence that happens in ones life. Need is a beautiful, mysterious reliance upon Yahweh that's formed within an understanding of the depth from which you have been saved. Not everyone knows this level of dependance and that's ok. Wanting a relationship with Yahweh initiates radical faith-based obedience. it is the first step you have to make by deciding you want to live a life that pleases Yahweh and

Yahshua. Your want for Yahweh drives decision making and because of this you become in relation through understanding and time. We learn to love what Yahweh loves by wanting Him. Now, it is not one or the other, it's both working together. Again, wanting Yahweh is the first step, then needing Him, depending upon Him, follows soon after. For those of you that need Yahweh, you can agree. For those of you who want a relationship with Yahweh, you can agree just as much.

Yahweh needs us and that's why His heart breaks when we sin. His love is so deep, so true, so just and yet we desire to satisfy ourselves. Our flesh convinces us to think attaining the desires of this world, material things, produces joy. Money does not satisfy, it possibly couldn't. Wanting things in this life only brings temporary happiness. Of course you were made with the desire to want things, it's apart of Yahweh's creation, but more times than not will our own desires be the very nature of our own death.

What do you do with your own needs and wants? Do you go about pleasing the desires of your flesh, or can you withhold from the temptation of more stuff. Yahweh needs us and He wants us, do we feel the same towards Him? If your looking to be full and never thirst again then run to the well which never runs dry, and of your looking to be filled then drink from the cup that always satisfies.
