### **☑ Do This...**

- Once you realize what you have done, don't go to sleep until you have remedied the situation.

### **<u>™</u>** The Ant…

Needs no captain! ...the quintessential self-motivated, self-governing, self-disciplined, self-regulating, self-starting industrious creature. The ant will get done what needs to get done without being told to do it!

#### Ant Facts

- ☑ There is an estimated 10 quadrillion ants (one million billion ants) in the world.
- The total weight of the world's ant population outweighs the total weight of the human population.
- The largest ant colony ever recorded was found in Europe. It was 3750 miles wide and made up of multiple colonies that came together to form a "super" colony.

- Ants keep regular daily shifts for working, sleeping, and eating.
- Ants live longer than any other type of insect—they can live up to 30 years!
- Ants have 250,000 brain cells and are believed to be the world's smartest insect.
- Ant colonies operate so efficiently that mathematicians used algorithms based on their behavior ("Ant Colony Algorithms"!) to build a supercomputer for NASA.
- Ants can survive underwater for up to two weeks because they have extremely tiny breathing tubes, which water can't penetrate.
- ☑ Every worker, soldier, and queen ant is female. Only drones are male. Drones don't do any colony work; their only function is to fertilize a princess ant. They die shortly thereafter.
- Ants can sense the Earth's magnetic field and use it for navigation.
- Ants communicate with one another using chemical pheromone trails. Colonies use these chemicals to work together so efficiently that they have been labelled "super-organisms" (multiple organisms working as one).

- Every ant colony has its own unique scent, so that intruder ants in a colony can be recognized immediately.
- If a man could run as fast as an ant relative to his size, he could run 34 miles per hour.
- Ants are the world's main turners of soil.
- Ants can carry 50-100 times their own body weight (depending on type), making them one of the world's strongest creatures relative to their own size.
- If an average man was as strong as an ant, he could lift up to 9 tons!

### **In contrast to the the ant...**

The ant is an industrious hard-worker. A sluggard is a lazy human who sleeps all day, has no ambition or drive, and is happy to waste hour upon hour resting, entertaining himself, and participating in useless activities that will advance nothing good in the Earth, nor in their personal lives.

- Poverty and lack will overtake the lazy man like a thief who breaks in at night and steals all his valuables, while he happily catches a few extra hours of unnecessary deep sleep.
- It will be like an enthusiastic coworker, who quickly advances past you, while you lazily accomplish the minimum tasks each day to remain employed like a bored drone.
- What you need to provide for your daily needs will suddenly seem unavailable, and you will feel helpless to do anything about it, as if you were being held at gunpoint.

#### The Wicked

"A worthless person, a wicked man, Walks with a perverse mouth; He winks with his eyes, He shuffles his feet, He points with his fingers; Perversity is in his heart, He devises evil continually, He sows discord. Therefore his calamity shall come suddenly; Suddenly he shall be broken without remedy. These six things the Lord hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood, A heart that devises

wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil, A false witness who speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren."

Proverbs 6:12-19 NKJV

#### **Proverbs 6:12-19**

- "A worthless person, a wicked man, Walks with a perverse mouth; He winks with his eyes, He shuffles his feet, He points with his fingers; Perversity is in his heart, He devises evil continually, He sows discord." Proverbs 6:12-14 NKJV
  - **Read these two verses over and over again...** 
    - ✓ Note see this relevant section in context in <u>A Power-</u><u>Worthy Church</u>. A message about the Feast of Pentecost
    - Meditate on the words and picture in your mind this type of person. You see these worthless wicked people every day, all around you, on the news, making speeches, and pushing their agendas.
    - They lie to you without shame or remorse. They gaslight you because they take you for a fool.
    - And maybe worse of all is that they do it, knowing they are doing it, and knowing that you know they are doing it, and yet they have no concern at all.
    - It is wickedness exemplified!
  - **✓** How can you recognize them?

- ☑ The Perverse Mouth: (a person; their actions, words, thoughts, and/or beliefs)
  - First let's define perverse...
    - Showing a deliberate and obstinate desire to behave in a way that is unreasonable or unacceptable, often in spite of the consequences.
    - ☑ Contrary to the accepted or expected standard or practice: (i.e. in the general election the outcome was quite perverse.)
    - ☑ Law (of a verdict) against the weight of evidence or the direction of the judge on a point of law.
- Winking Eyes: You know the look; it's the silent gesture offered that says to select persons watching, "You know what I'm doing, and you know what I mean by what I'm saying, and you know my real agenda, but all these "fools" are being led like blind men into a ditch."
- Shuffling Feet: It is like the soft shoe tap dance of a used car salesman, the celebratory dance of a man who knows his victim has bought what he is selling. And literally in these present these days (2024), the false, dishonestly elected leader of the free world shuffles his feet as a sign of his decaying mental state.

- Pointing Fingers: This wicked man points his finger to identify in his audience each of his wicked accomplices, those who have joined him in his evil agenda.
- Perverse Heart: This man has a darkened wicked heart. His conscience is seared, and all of his beliefs and actions are in alignment with the enemy of our souls.
  - A deliberate and obstinate desire to behave in a way that is unreasonable or unacceptable, often in spite of the consequences
  - Contrary to the accepted or expected standard or practice.
  - Against the weight of evidence or the direction of the judge on a point of law.
- Constantly Devising Evil: What else is there for a wicked man to do than to devise wicked plans?
  - ☑ Look around again, and you will see that every policy of those in charge has an agenda to bring controversy, destruction, poverty, conflict, separation, bondage and crises. The current president and his administration (2024) is the most divisive there has ever been in the history of the United States of America.

- **☑** ...One who sows \*discord...
  - This man sows strife in hopes of harvesting chaos.
    - Discord: strife, conflict, friction, hostility;
      disagreement, lack of agreement, dissension, dispute,
      discordance, disunity, division, incompatibility,
      antagonism, enmity, opposition, bad blood, argument,
      quarreling, wrangling, feuding, contention, clashing,
      falling-out, war, vendetta.
- "Therefore his calamity shall come suddenly; Suddenly he shall be broken without remedy." Proverbs 6:15 NKJV
  - **This is what these wicked people have coming to them...** 
    - Sudden Calamity: Even in the midst of feeling they are being successful, carrying out their demonic plans, God will enact His vengeance upon them, and they will be destroyed without moment's notice.

Lives Shattered without remedy: Both their lives here on earth and their eternal lives will be destroyed—their destiny of damnation is sealed for eternity and there will be no way to reverse God's ruling.

### **☑** The Sin that Leads to Death

- When one see a phrase as such that indicate there is no remedy, one can't help, but think of *The Sin that Leads to Death*—blasphemy of the Holy Spirit for which there is no remedy. It is the unforgivable sin!
- When you look into the eyes of today's leaders who are propagating such evil schemes as mentioned above, you can observe the darkness within a person who has been overtaken in such a way that they can't ever repent for their sinful behaviors.
- There is only sin (type of sin) for which there is no remedy, and that is the one for which there is no possibility of repentance (one who has a seared conscience will NEVER repent).

☑ [to hate personally; an enemy or foe; utterly odious.]

#### **It is an 'Abomination'...**

[disgusting or detestable, abominable; in an ethical sense—wickedness.]

## **■ 1. A proud look (pride and haughtiness)**

- To rise, rise up, be high, be lofty, to exalt oneself. It's the "i" in pride that says the most. "It's all about me and what is best for me, even if it requires creating a god in my own image."
  - Current Events: it's government for the elite by the elite, as opposed to for the people by the people.

    Every decision made by those at the helm is meant to oppress the people, weaken the people, and make the people needy, all in an effort to stay in power. It's a self-centeredness so malignant that there is no longer an attempt to cover-up the lies and deception. The presumption is that the people are so beat-down,

dumbed-down, and down-and-out, that they have no energy, nor intellect, to resist the abuse.

## **■ 2. A lying tongue (deception):**

- Any deceitful, fraudulent, or false words. The unrighteous will not inherit the Kingdom of Heaven (I Cor. 6:9). If you abide in Christ, you will know the truth and the truth will set you free (John 8:31-32) whereas lying is a prison.

  "But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."" Revelation 21:8

  NKIV
  - ✓ **Current Events:** the real question about the current administration (the president and all his people and agencies) is this: "Is there one statement, one word, one report, one press conference, one explanation, or one news story that is true?" The answer is, "No!"

### **3.** Hands that shed innocent blood (murder):

- ☑ The power or strength to take a life. "You shall not murder." Exodus 20:13 NKJV
  - ☑ Current Events: think of how many lives have been lost because of the current administration's foreign and domestic policies. Wars are raging around the world;

the Middle East is in chaos; thousands of people have died (many of them Jews); all because of its permissiveness, every policy a deliberate decision. Domestic borders are opened and thousands of American are dying from drugs pouring into our land. And every drop of innocent blood is on Joe Biden's hands. How many have died because of oppressive energy and fiscal polices that have ruined the economy and caused exceeding stress on susceptible people? How many have died because of evil vaccine and lockdown policies? How many have lost their lives and livelihoods because a nation was forced to close for business. The blood is running in the streets and those in charge are stained in crimson from head to toe.

## **■ 4. A heart that devises wicked plans**

- ☑ The state of being of the inner man, mind, will, and understanding to create trouble, wickedness and iniquity.
  - Current Events: all of the escalating wickedness we are witnessing has been cleverly devised, on purpose.
     These are men and women with darkened hearts, whose intention is pure evil. They each have a seared conscience with no remaining ability to repent, having

crossed the line of the unpardonable sin. Their plan is to twist and confuse the truth about gender; the destruction of marriage and the family, and the murder of the unborn, all while claiming to adhere to some brand of Christianity, even while simultaneously mocking God and His truths.

### **☑** 5. Feet that are swift to run to evil

- Actions that hasten to all things bad, malignant, miserable, vicious, wicked, injurious, and distressing.
  - Current Events: these evil wicked people do all of these things, and they do them quickly. They do not hesitate to seize every opportunity to bring darkness, wrath and evil into every situation. They will not pass up on a single opportunity to twist the truth or fabricate a falsehood, as long as it serves their evil agenda. And when they are exposed, they double down, quickly accusing their opponents of committing the very atrocities they themselves have invented and in which they willing participate.

## **<u>⊌</u> <u>6. A false witness who speaks lies</u>**

Any deceitful, fraudulent, or false words **as a witness**, with the intention to bearing false testimony or to present false evidence, for the purpose of deceiving others and to

inflame a situation. "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor." Exodus 20:16 NKJV

**Current Events:** every case, every legal suit, every crime, and every accusation they've accused their opponents of committing, have been fabricated on false testimony and lies. They've used illegal surveillance, a fraudulent dossier, Russian collusion and unjustified impeachments. The DOJ and State Justice departments, in collusion with the Biden administration, have fabricated lawsuits over property valuations, fake insurrections, classified documents, business records, and RICO charges as an attempt to overthrow the election—all to persecute their political opponent, like we see in third-world nations. And they do so while Joe Biden and his family are actually the ones committing the real crimes, too many to name, but all treasonous! And all while they humorously and unsuccessfully attempt to cover-up Joe Biden serious dementia and cognitive decay.

### **IDENTIFY 7. One who sows discord (hostility and disunity)**

☑ Discord: strife, conflict, hostility, dissension, disunity, division, antagonism, enmity, opposition, bad blood, contention, clashing, war, vendetta.

- Current Events: Here I picked the worst of what we see as the discord and lawfare propagated by the current president and his administration (DOJ, DHS, Foreign Policy, Energy Policy, Fiscal Policy, etc) his party, corporate media and social media, etc. Everything they institute is meant to cause discord and dissension.
- And yet, what is our job? "Repay no one evil for evil.

  Have regard for good things in the sight of all men. If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men. Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord." Romans 12:17-19 NKJV
- The remedy against the wicked and his plans!
  - This is how our victory is secured! This is why we need not repay evil for evil!
    - "Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity. For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, And wither as the green herb. Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way

to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday. Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; Do not fret—it only causes harm. For evildoers **shall be cut off;** But those who wait on the Lord, They shall inherit the earth. For yet a little while and the wicked shall be no more; Indeed, you will look carefully for his place, But it shall be no more. But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. The wicked plots against the just, And gnashes at him with his teeth. The Lord laughs at him, For He sees that his day is coming. The wicked have drawn the sword And have bent their bow, To cast down the poor and needy, To slay those who are of upright conduct. Their sword shall enter their own heart, And their bows shall be broken. A little that a righteous man has Is better than the riches of many wicked. For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, But the Lord upholds the righteous. The Lord knows the days of the upright, And their inheritance shall be forever. They shall

not be ashamed in the evil time, And in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. **But the wicked shall** perish; And the enemies of the Lord, Like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish. Into smoke they shall vanish away. The wicked borrows and does not repay, But the righteous shows mercy and gives. For those blessed by Him shall inherit the earth, But those cursed by Him shall be cut off. The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, And He delights in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the Lord upholds him with His hand. I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, Nor his descendants begging bread. He is ever merciful, and lends; And his descendants are blessed. Depart from evil, and do good; And dwell forevermore. For the Lord loves justice, And does not forsake His saints; They are preserved forever, But the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off. The righteous shall inherit the land, And dwell in it forever. The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, And his tongue talks of justice. The law of his God is in his heart; None of his steps shall slide. **The** wicked watches the righteous, And seeks to slay him. The Lord will not leave him in his hand, Nor condemn

him when he is judged. Wait on the Lord, And keep His way, And He shall exalt you to inherit the land; When the wicked are cut off, you shall see it. I have seen the wicked in great power, And spreading himself like a native green tree. Yet he passed away, and behold, he was no more; Indeed I sought him, but he could not be found. Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; For the future of that man is peace. But the transgressors shall be destroyed together; The future of the wicked shall be cut off. But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is their strength in the time of trouble. ### **☑** Love—the OPPOSITE the Wicked

"Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails..."

I Corinthians 13:4-8 NKJV

Beware of Adultery (See: The Lips of an Immoral Woman)

"My son, keep your **father's command**, And do not forsake the law of your mother. Bind them continually upon your heart; Tie them around your neck. When you roam, they will lead you; When you sleep, they will keep you; And when you awake, they will speak with you. ### **The Seriousness of God's Commands**

- A common theme throughout the proverbs, especially the early proverbs, is the critical nature of knowing and obeying the Lord's commands.
- Here again it is reiterated specifically to protect you from the gateway sin—sexual immorality. See <a href="In the Image of God">In the Image of God</a> for an exhaustive teaching on the gateway sin.
- All of Proverbs 5 (See: <u>The Lips of an Immoral Woman</u>) and upcoming in Proverbs 7, the perils of sexual immorality are front and center.
- ☑ The rest of this chapter further clarifies and reiterates the warnings. Here we emphasize the consequences!

✓ \*\*Do not lust\* after her beauty in your heart, Nor let her allure you with her eyelids. For by means of a harlot A man is reduced to a crust of bread; And an adulteress will prey upon his precious life.\*\* Proverbs 6:25-26 NKJV

## **<u>Some Sequences for lusting after outward beauty...</u>**

- A man is reduced to crust of bread: the crust is that which is symbolic of what is insignificant. It is the part that is cut off and discarded, often burned, charred and having lost it's rich flavor.
- The object of his lust will hunt and feed upon his life: every aspect of life is invaded and destroyed when one is seduced by a harlot.
- Sexual Immorality is the gateway sin leading to a cascade of abominable behaviors.
  - **☑** The Gateway Sin (again refer to: In the Image of God)
    - "And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; being filled with all unrighteousness, [#1] sexual immorality, [and all else follows] wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evilmindedness; they are whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things,

disobedient to parents, undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them."

Romans 1:28-32 NKJV

- "Can a man take fire to his bosom, And his clothes **not be**burned? Can one walk on hot coals, And his feet **not be**seared? So is he who goes in to his neighbor's wife; Whoever touches her shall not be innocent." Proverbs 6:27-29 NKJV
  - **<u>Ine consequences of adultery...</u>** 
    - ☑ It will be like breathing in fire, being baked alive in an oven, and standing still on a searing red-hot grill—simultaneously.
    - ✓ Question: Can you do so and not suffer the devastating effects?
- "People do not despise a thief If he steals to satisfy himself when he is starving. Yet when he is found, he must restore sevenfold; He may have to give up all the substance of his house." Proverbs 6:30-31 NKJV

- **Compare a common thief to a man who commits**adultery...
  - In some circumstances, you can even understand why a man might rob another man. You might even have compassion, believing he has done so based on a desperate need.
  - And even then, the cost for thievery is very high!
  - He must restore what he has stolen sevenfold, even if it costs everything he has!
- "Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks understanding; He who does so destroys his own soul.
  Wounds and dishonor he will get, And his reproach will not be wiped away." Proverbs 6:32-33 NKJV
  - **As opposed to a common thief, an adulterous man...** 
    - ...does not only lose his earthly possessions.
      - ✓ His reputation will be a irreparably damaged and...
      - ...his soul will be in serious jeopardy into eternity.
- "For jealousy is a husband's fury; Therefore he will not spare
  in the day of vengeance. He will accept no recompense, Nor
  will he be appeased though you give many gifts." Proverbs
  6:34-35 NKJV

## **■ Beyond his reputation...**

- ☑ The husband that was scorned may display a furious jealousy that inspires pure vengeance.
- ☑ He might never accept an apology, nor any level of remorse, nor any amount of repayment of any sort to appease his fury.
- ☑ In other words, and adulteress man may have a permanent bounty on his head, as long as he lives.
