 - ☑ The apple of your eye: That which is treasured above everything and everyone else.

What is the apple of your eye? ■

- ☑ Doing things God's way should be ever at the tip of your fingers and at the center of your thoughts.
- ☑ That is what you would call a life lived with godly wisdom, and understanding.
- "Say to wisdom, "You are my sister," And call understanding your nearest kin, That they may keep you from the immoral woman, From the seductress who flatters with her words."

 Proverbs 7:4-5 NKJV
 - ☑ These should be as close to your heart as your dearest family member.
 - ☑ Wisdom: the application of Godly knowledge and understanding.
 - **Knowledge:** the acquisition of God's intent on any matter.
 - **☑ Understanding:** the proper perception of God's intention.
 - **Wisdom and Understanding will give you protection...**
 - From the seductive immoral woman!

The Crafty Harlot

So I came out to meet you, Diligently to seek your face, And I have found you. I have **spread my bed** with tapestry, Colored coverings of Egyptian linen. ☑ Character traits of the victim of the harlot:

- Simple: having or showing very little intelligence or judgment, naive, and foolish.
- Young: immature, unprepared, lack of experience, a boy and not a man!
- ☑ Devoid of Understanding: entirely lacking proper perception of God's intention, lacking good judgment, a weak mind, a weak resolve, and poor morals.
- "And there a woman met him, With the attire of a harlot, and a crafty heart. She was loud and rebellious, Her feet would not stay at home. At times she was outside, at times in the open square, Lurking at every corner." Proverbs 7:10-12 NKJV
 - ☑ Character traits of the harlot (note: the harlot can be male of female):

- ☑ Appearance (attire): She dresses the part. Clothing designed to create temptation. Garments made to allure, to inspire lust and to awaken desire.
- Intentions (heart): She is scheming. What she is doing is not by accident. Her thoughts and plans are purposeful with one desired outcome, and that is to trap her victim in her scheme.
- Personality (loud and rebellious): She wants to be noticed. There is nothing subtle about how she comes across to others. She desires to draw attention to herself and makes no effort to hide that what she is doing is in violation of God's will. In other words, she is sinning on purpose and has no remorse.
- Lifestyle (on the move): She is actively pursuing her business. She's going where she needs to go to attain what she wants and establish her schemes. She goes where the business is, wherever the men are present and vulnerable to temptation. That is where she will set up shop. She is industrious when it comes to ensuring her sinful plans are successful.

Help from the Lord!

<u>Ine Target: "She caught him..." Who?</u>

The man with very little intelligence or judgment. The naive and foolish man with no more scruples than an immature, unprepared little boy, with no experience. The man with no deep roots or solid foundation in the Lord (a Godly man would not be easily enticed). The man entirely lacking proper perception of God's intention. The man with a weak mind, a weak resolve, and poor morals.

<u>Ine Trap: the bold move!</u>

She caught him and kissed him... How audacious! When you are so bold and so certain that you can control the outcome that you would walk right up to somebody and grab them, certain they are willing to participate in your sinful schemes.

- With an impudent face... This can only be done if you have absolutely zero concern or respect for the other person.
- I have peace offerings with me; Today I have paid my vows... And then to make it even worse, bring God into the equation, as if you are in right standing with Him.
 Use your relationship with God, as if He is pleased with you because you took care of business with Him already: obediently wrote your tithe check, did your daily devotions, and worshipped your wonderful Creator.
- ✓ I came out to meet you... I took care of my business.

 with the Lord, so now I'm available to come out and play. I specifically came out to meet you, knowing you would be impressed with my wonderful priorities of putting God first.
- "I have **spread my bed** with tapestry, Colored coverings of Egyptian linen. I have **perfumed my bed** With myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon. **Come, let us take our fill of love until morning; Let us delight ourselves with love.**" Proverbs 7:16-18 NKJV
 - **☑** The Unabashed Offer!

- I've prepared a night of sexual fantasy for you, pleasure you deserve. I've made myself completely available to satisfy your sexual desires.
- And we will call what we are doing love, even though it is clearly sin. We can still claim it is love; all we have to do is make a few alterations in the definition.
 - ▼ This is how... Alter the following attributes of love and we can have our own new expedient definition that suites our specific needs! (We need only alter 12 of the 16 attributes so the new definition fits our needs!)
 - Love: "Love suffers long [love gets what it wants without waiting] and is kind [love considers what's best for me]; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely [love does not care if it offends someone else], does not seek its own [love seeks to satisfy its own desires], is not provoked, thinks no evil [love redefines sin]; does not rejoice in iniquity [love defends its sinful ways], but rejoices in the truth [love teaches that truth is relative to one's needs in the moment]; bears all things [love is weak and cannot stand up under scrutiny], believes all things [love believes the things of God that fit into a model that works for me], hopes all things

[love does not have the faith that God has my best interest in mind], endures all things [love is weak and therefore must be bolstered by my own philosophy]. Love never fails [love is not permanent; it has no real power; it has an easily alterable meaning]..." I

Corinthians 13:4-8 NKJV

- ☑ That's not too difficult if you are willing to participate in self-deception.
- Yes, the secret to pulling this off is self-deception. We move away from "delighting in the Lord" to "delighting in ourselves." "Let us delight ourselves with love."
 - ✓ Unfortunately: this is the exact opposite of what God says to do!
 - "Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday." Psalms 37:3-6 NKJV
- ☑ But, if we keep the shift subtle, you may not notice you've crossed over from worshiping Yahweh to worshiping Satan, the king of My way!

✓ Satan's Way: "I will!"

""How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations! For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north; I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.'" Isaiah 14:12-14 NKJV

Yah's way or My way

- The question each of us must ask ourself; "Whose way will I choose, my way or Yah's way?
 - This reminded me of a Song made famous by Frank Sinatra called "My Way." Such tragic lyrics to sing if you think that doing it Your Way throughout your lifetime is the way to live.
 - Here I changed "my way" to "His way" six times and "himself" to "God" one time, seven small changes that make all the difference in this life and into eternity!

Willful Premeditated Sin!

- ☑ The focus here is not that this sinful woman is married, as much as it is that her sin is premeditated.
- She has planned her fornication around the schedule of her husband who is away on business and she knows precisely what day he will return, so she knows exactly

- how much time she has to engage in her sinful sexual immorality.
- In addition, for all those who are unmarried, when you engage in sexual immorality of any type, you are being unfaithful to your future spouse.
- **☑** God's Word Speaks for itself when it comes to willful sin!
- "For if we sin willfully after we have received the V knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has **trampled** the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. And again, "The Lord will judge His people." It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God." Hebrews 10:26-31 NKIV
- ☑ God's Word Speaks for itself when it comes to sexual immorality!

- "I wrote to you in my epistle not to keep company with sexually immoral people. Yet I certainly did not mean with the sexually immoral people of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world. But now I have written to you not to keep company with anyone named a brother, who is sexually immoral, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or an extortioner—not even to eat with such a person." I Corinthians 5:9-11 NKJV
- "Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God." I Corinthians 6:9-10 NKJV
 - Note to self: genuine repentance brings eternal forgiveness, but does not alleviate the consequences for sin here on earth during this life.
 - ✓ See: Forgiven... yet Liable
- "With her enticing speech she caused him to yield, With her flattering lips she seduced him." Proverbs 7:21 NKJV

The Web: enticing speech and flattering lips:

- ☑ Her allure goes beyond her appearance. She knows just what to say to draw her victim into her deadly web.
- Flattery is an interesting sin; it is often the one type of lie that a person is willing to believe, even though they know it's a lie.
- "Immediately he went after her, as an ox goes to the slaughter, Or as a fool to the correction of the stocks, Till an arrow struck his liver. As a bird hastens to the snare, He did not know it would cost his life." Proverbs 7:22-23 NKJV

He is defenseless!

- The analogies we can use to describe the outcome of entering her web are endless.
- The tragedy here is that for some reason, in his simplicity, his naivety, his self-deception, and the allure for sexual immorality, he did not know that it would cost him his very life.
- And maybe even more tragic is that he will run into it full speed, reckless abandoned, just to satisfy his sinful lustful desires—all while swearing in his deceived mind that what he is doing is...Love!.
 - ☑ The Love of the Flesh

- "Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever." I John 2:15-17 NKJV

 - **☑** Final Warning: Don't do it!
 - You will not be her first victim, nor her last.
 - Many have gone before you and were ruined by her, and many will come after you.
 - All will be led into the pit of hell; death awaits all those who choose the wide road that leads to destruction.
 - ""Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate

and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it." Matthew 7:13-14 NKJV
